TOP 10 actions

To protect beautiful McGregor lake, its shoreline and its wildlife, for present and future generations, your Association is active in the following ways:



Every year, install **buoys and/or signage to mark dangerous rocks** and to flag sensitive areas where Eurasian Water-milfoil has been seen in order to fight this invasive aquatic plant.



Coordinate dedicated **water testers** who collect **water quality samples** for the municipality and also for the Association to conduct E. coli testing to understand the water quality in our lake.



Maintain our **website** and communicate throughout the year via our **Facebook group and direct emails** to keep you informed.



Organize events for members and residents such as the **Regatta and Family Picnic** and encourage participation in the annual **Canadian Lakes Loon Survey** and the **Christmas Bird Count**.



Provide an opportunity for our members to ask questions and raise issues with the Mayor and Councillors who attend our **Annual General Meeting**.



Build awareness around **safe and responsible boating** practices through direct communications.



Maintain a proactive and constructive **relationship with Val-des-Monts' council and administration**.



Collaborate with **other lake associations** to share information on issues important to our members.



Help **strengthen our sense of community** with swag and merchandise, and special projects such as the lake map and members directory.



Finally, our radar is always on to **identify potential issues and find new solutions** to keep our lake beautiful and healthy.
